

## STUDENT ACTIVITIES

The school encourages students to support extra-curricular activities, such as athletic contests, parties, academic competitions, etc. Dress and behavior should be suited to the activity. When we are the host for interschool activity, our behavior sets the standard for our visitors. When we visit another school, our behavior reflects on our entire student body. Behavior that is inappropriate may be reason for exclusion from future activities. **NOTE: Students must be in attendance by second period or have a doctor's note to participate in extra-curricular activities. Weekend participation is not tied to Friday attendance.**

### ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

For the purposes of determining eligibility for extra-curricular activities, grade verifications will be conducted on the predetermined dates listed below. Students must have a passing grade in all subjects. If, during the grade verification, a student is not passing all classes, he will be ruled ineligible. During the first period of ineligible status, students may still attend practices but not participate in contests. Students will be able to earn an eligible status only during the next scheduled verification check. If a student is ruled ineligible for a second time during any one season, he will be removed from the roster and must turn in his equipment and uniform. Any student participating in an after-school athletic event will be included in the grade checks during the season of their participation. Events that shall be included (but not limited to) are football, volleyball, wrestling, track, basketball, tennis, intramurals, cheerleading, and student council.

During the school year, verification will be conducted on the following dates:
